Potty Training:

A “steps to success” letter will be given to you as your child shows interest in toileting, or reaches an age when introduction may be necessary.



Characteristics of a toddler program:

- Introduction to nursery school setting
- Reinforcement of learning areas and limits
- Many choices available
- Reward system introduced with child and parents
- Potty training

Classroom Rules:

Our classroom rules are designed to help children learn positive social skills and to provide a safe environment for all children. Your cooperation of reinforcing our safety rules will add consistency, which is vital for young children.

- Walking feet
- Indoor voices
- Gentle touches
- Keeping our hands to ourselves
- Using our good manners

Toddlers don't share but they can learn to take turns. When a rule has been given and a child chooses to ignore it, we then reinforce our role as a keeper of promises and enforce consistent consequences.

Parent/Teacher Communication:

Day sheets will be sent home daily with information regarding your child's general day. If you wish to call and speak to a teacher, a good time to call is between 12:30-2:45. This is our naptime and the staff will be available to speak to you. Of course, if you need to speak with us earlier, please don't hesitate to call. Every January and June you will receive a progress report for your child. You may request a Parent/Teacher Conference to discuss your child's development.

Summer Camp:

When the warmer weather arrives, our classroom schedule changes to accommodate more outside fun. We spend a lot of time outside engaged in water play and other activities. You will be asked to bring in a swimsuit, towel, sunscreen, water shoes, and hat (if desired).
