Directions:

1. To prepare the sensory bags, scoop out the inside of a pumpkin and place it in a gallon-size Ziploc bag.
2. Add in the erasers or other plastic shapes
3. After the bags are prepared, invite the children to explore them. Let them squish the bags and search for items inside.

Mummy Dogs – Great cooking activity for little ones!

Ingredients:

1. Hot dogs or mini hotdogs
2. Crescent rolls

Instructions:

1. Preheat the oven to 375 degrees F.
2. Open your crescent roll package and unroll the dough. Press on the perforations to seal them together.
3. Cut the dough into 1/4 inch strips.
4. Wrap the pieces of dough around each hot dog creating bandages by stretching the dough slightly and letting it overlap and crisscross.
5. Place each wrapped hot dog on a baking sheet and then bake for 10-12 minutes or until the dough is golden brown and hot dogs are warmed through.
