Snowstorm in a Jar

When it's too cold to go outside, try this fun and easy experiment indoors!

You will need:

Oil (vegetable or baby oil)

White washable paint

Alka-Seltzer Tablets

A large cup, jar, or vase



1. Add 1 cup of water to the vase or large jar
2. Mix in 1 tsp of paint (acrylic glitter paint works)
3. Pour oil in almost to the top of the container
4. Break Alka-Seltzer tablet into pieces and drop one at a time into the oil. You may want to add additional pieces for a blizzard!

Easy Two Ingredient Snow Popsicles
