# Salt Crystal Snowflakes

## You will need:

- Salt
- Mason Jars (1 for each snowflake)
- Pipe Cleaners
- Clothes Pins



1. Boil three cups of water per mason jar. When the water boils, start adding salt and continue adding until crystals start to form on the surface of the water.
2. Design and make your pipe cleaner snowflakes while the water cools
3. Attach a clothes pin to the stem of each snowflake and then suspend into the mason jar.
4. Let Snowflakes sit in a sunny window for 2-3 days
5. Remove snowflakes and let dry

## Easy Two Ingredient Snow Popsicles

- 2 Packages or "Cups" Pudding
- 6 Cups of Fresh, Clean Snow
- Optional Sprinkles or Syrups

Mix pudding with fresh gathered snow, along with any additional sprinkles. Then, pack the mixture into popsicle molds and allow to set in the freezer for at least 4 hours to refreeze. Enjoy!
