Rainbow walking water experiment

Supplies:

- Small plastic cups or glasses
 - Paper Towels
 - Food coloring in primary colors
 - Water
1. Place 7 cups in a row and pour water in the 1st, 3rd, 5th, and 7th cup. Fill about 3/4 full.
 2. Add 5 drops of red coloring to the 1st and 7th cup
 3. Add 5 drops of yellow to the 3rd cup
 4. Add 5 drops of blue to the 5th cup
 5. Take a half sheet of paper towel and fold it in half lengthwise, twice. Trim off some length to that there isn't too much excess that will stick up in the air between cups.
 6. Place one half of a paper towel in the 1st cup and the other half in the second cup. Then add another paper towel from the 2nd cup into the 3rd, and so on until there is paper towel in all cups.
 7. Watch for the water to start crawling up the paper towel!

Recipe for Oobleck

Ingredients:

Comstarch
Food Coloring
Water

Procedure:

1. Pour 1 cup of water into a large bowl.
2. Add food coloring of your choice and stir.
3. Add 1 cup of Comstarch to bowl of colored water.
4. Stir until comstarch is dissolved.
5. Pour Oobleck out on a sheet wax paper.
